Handwork

- ☐ basic sewing kit – needles, pins, scissors, assorted color threads, embroidery floss

Child Development 1

- ☐ open floor space where you can roll across the room, belly crawl and crawl, etc.
- ☐ small bean bag. If you do not have one, please improvise. Perhaps you could fill a small ziplock with rice, for example.
- ☐ crayon, can be regular or block crayon
- ☐ large piece of paper
- ☐ tape
- ☐ blindfold, can be a scarf or piece of fabric to tie around your face to cover your eyes

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- ☐ cloth napkin
- ☐ small metal bowl if you have one, or other non-breakable small bowl
- ☐ Sand - can be outside or in a container
- ☐ Sunflower seeds or rice – about 3 cups

Watercolor Painting

- ☐ Table space or paint boards for 2 paintings (paintings will need to dry in place for at least 2 hours)
- ☐ Paint Brush (½ -1" Flat or Wash)
- ☐ Paint Cloth or paper towels (for wiping)
- ☐ 2 Large Water Jars (for rinsing your brush)
- ☐ 2 sheets of watercolor paper (10 sheets provided in your supplies box)
- ☐ Baggies of Paint (provided in your supplies box. We will go over how to prepare them during class)
- ☐ 4-8 oz Resealable jars (to store your paint in)
- ☐ Clean Tub or Sink (to soak paper in)
- ☐ Clean sponge

- ☐ scissors
- ☐ two of the same tall, skinny objects that won't break if they fall from your hand. Suggestions: wrapping paper rolls, peacock feathers, brooms, yardsticks, or non-breakable water bottles. We are going to balance these items on our hands – open palm.
- ☐ an open floor space where you can roll across the room, belly crawl and crawl, etc.
- ☐ cloth napkin
- ☐ small soft toy or a rolled-up sock
- ☐ couple small metal bowls, or other non-breakable small bowl, such as tupperware containers.
- ☐ non-breakable drinking glasses or something that you can stack.
- ☐ two small bean bags. If you don't have any, please improvise - fill a small ziplock with rice, for example
- ☐ herb plant (rosemary, lavender, sage, thyme) **in a pot** – it does not need to be large
